- a graduate degree in a pastoral discipline (e.g., Divinity, Ministry, or Theology) with postgraduate clinical training.

Credentialing: One or both of the following:

- a license from the State of Oregon for clinical mental health practice (e.g., LCSW, LPC, or LMFT).
- a certified membership in the American Association of Pastoral Counselors (i.e., Certified Pastoral Counselor, Fellow, or Diplomate).

Clinical experience: 3 years of supervised counseling experience and/or clinical pastoral education required; 2 years with underserved clients in a non-profit agency preferred.

Theoretical orientation: Analytical psychology, ego psychology, object relations, self psychology, attachment theory, and/or family systems preferred.
